1. Rama Pir No Tekra Community Center, Ahmedabad, Gujarat

- 12 day workshop, 2 hrs per day
- 12 children from 3 slums
- System installed in community center library for day-lighting



2. Patangyu Community School, Ahmedabad, Gujarat

- Light in 1-room school
- No prior electricity connection
- 12 day workshop, 2 hrs/day
- 10-15 boys and girls, age 6-17



3. ASSET school in Wakro, Arunachal Pradesh

- 3 day workshop
- 15 learners from 3 schools (private and gov't)
- Ages 14-16, 75% girls
- Grid-connected but frequent outages
- Light installed in hostel dining hall, 6 solar lamps donated



4. Intaya public school in Roing, Arunachal Pradesh

- 3 day workshop
- 15 learners
- Ages 14-17
- Grid-connected but frequent outages
- Light installed in hostel dining hall, 5 solar lamps donated



5. Khati Chitra village, Gujarat

- Installed in the house of Gandhian teacher where village meetings and school is held
- No road access, electricity
- 1.5 day installation/training
- 3 solar lamps donated



6. Public school, Melghat, Maharashtra

- 3 day workshop
- 12 children, 75% boys
- Hostel school
- No electricity access, several solar systems
- Solar light system installed in girl's hostel, and 6 solar study lamps donated
